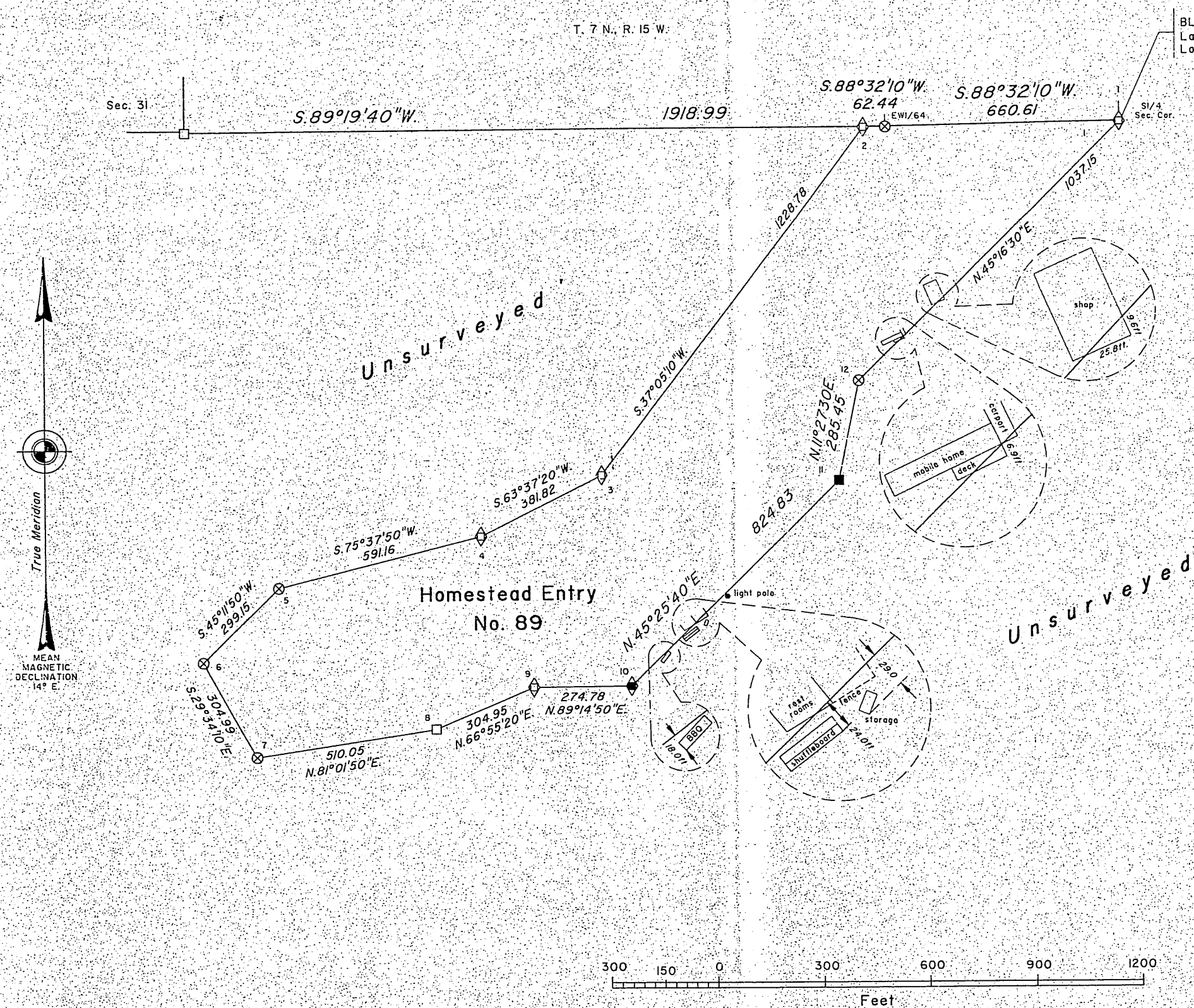
## DEPENDENT RESURVEY
